WATER PUMP

BLOCK PLAY



Wooden blocks are part of the Preschool's "continuous provision" – that is, resources, equipment and play and learning opportunities that are available for the children throughout the week for most of the day. Children are free to use the blocks as they choose. The structure around that freedom is that everyone stays safe, we share the blocks and space and take turns with others. Also a responsibility to be involved in putting the blocks away is engendered. The blocks are played with by individual children, with a friend or sometimes large teams get involved in a big project. Often, other play equipment gets introduced – dolls house furniture, cars, dinosaurs, farm and zoo animals.
