NATIONAL TREE DAY JULY 30

Is an opportunity to do something positive for your local environment and community and to reconnect with nature & aims to inspire, educate and recruit Australians to actively care for our unique land and create future generations of committed environmental custodians.

With the support of a funding grant from the NSW Environmental Trust, Duffys Forest Residents Association (DFRA) is celebrating National Tree Day on Sunday 30 July with a tree-planting event at Waratah Park@ 13 Namba Road, Duffys Forest between 9- 2pm.

As part of the ongoing restoration and rehabilitation work 500 of the proposed 5,000 native tube stock will be planted on the day.

This will help to restore and beautify degraded areas of the Park, increase biodiversity and provide additional wildlife habitat.

Tools will be provided however participants must wear appropriate clothing including a hat and footwear. Supervised children are welcome. Morning tea and refreshments are provided and lunch after the tree planting.
