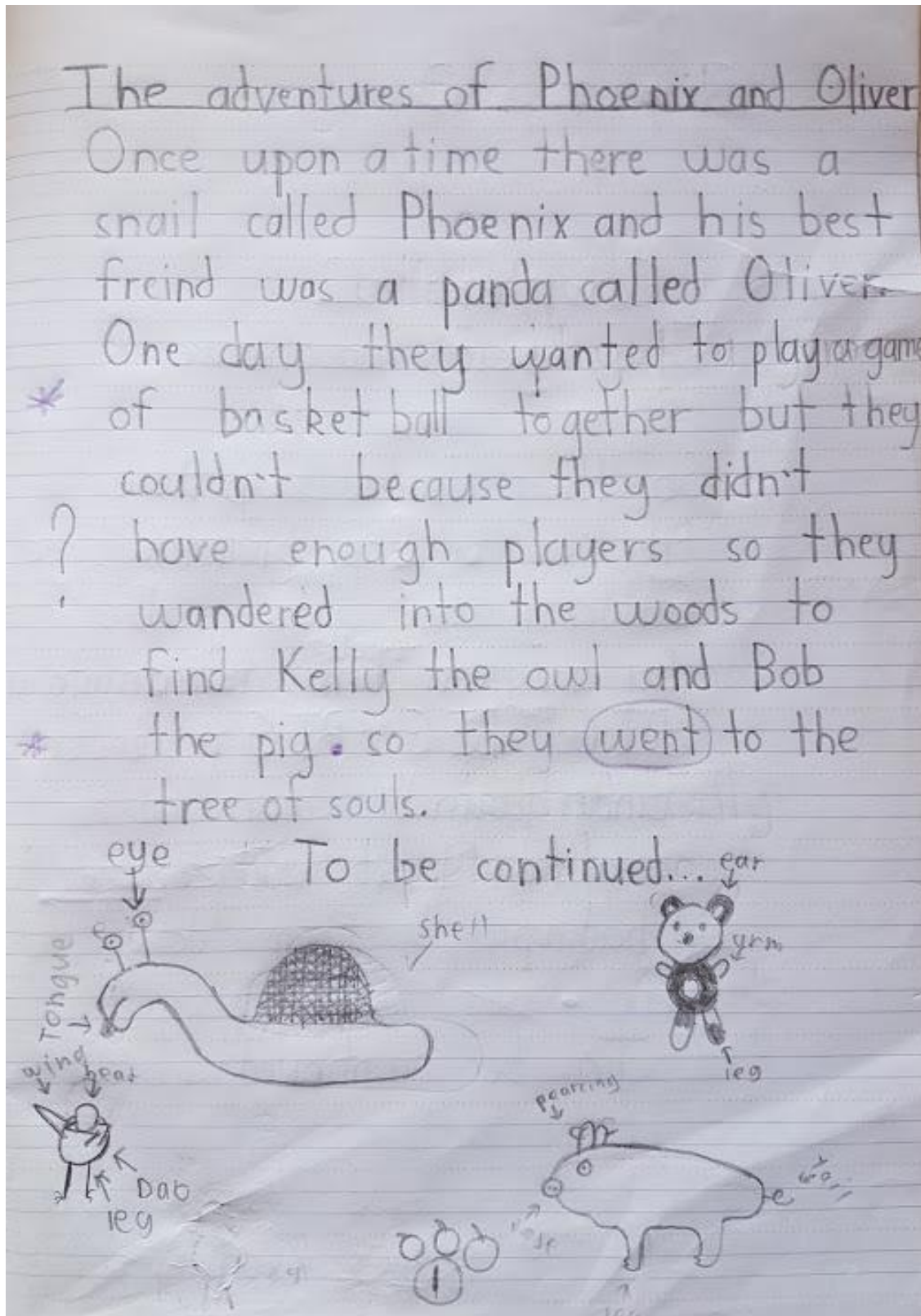


## Group 2 News

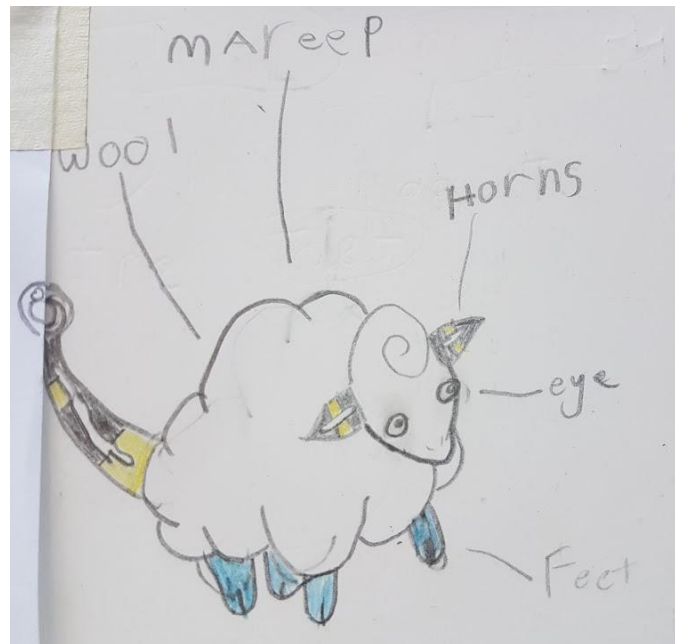

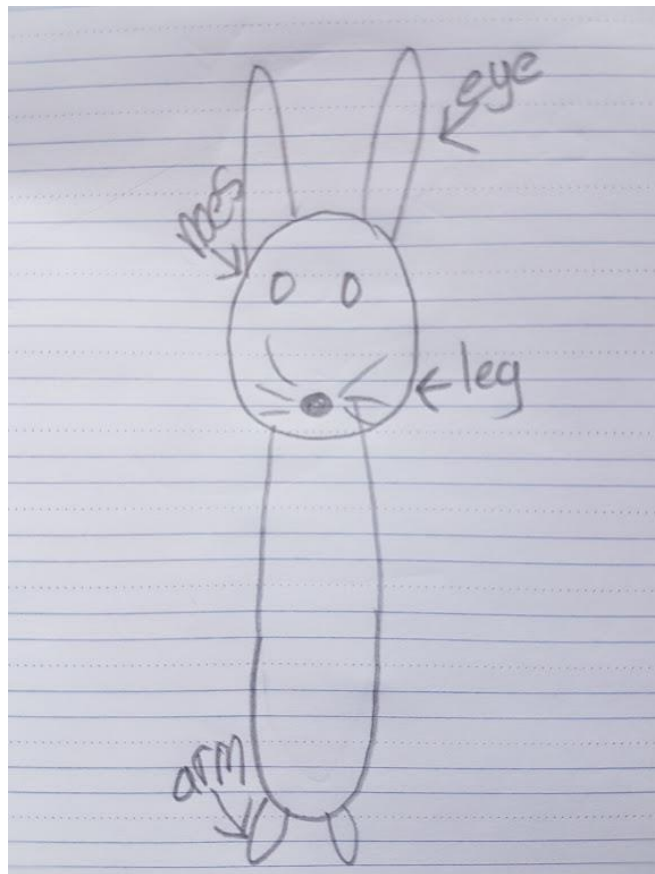

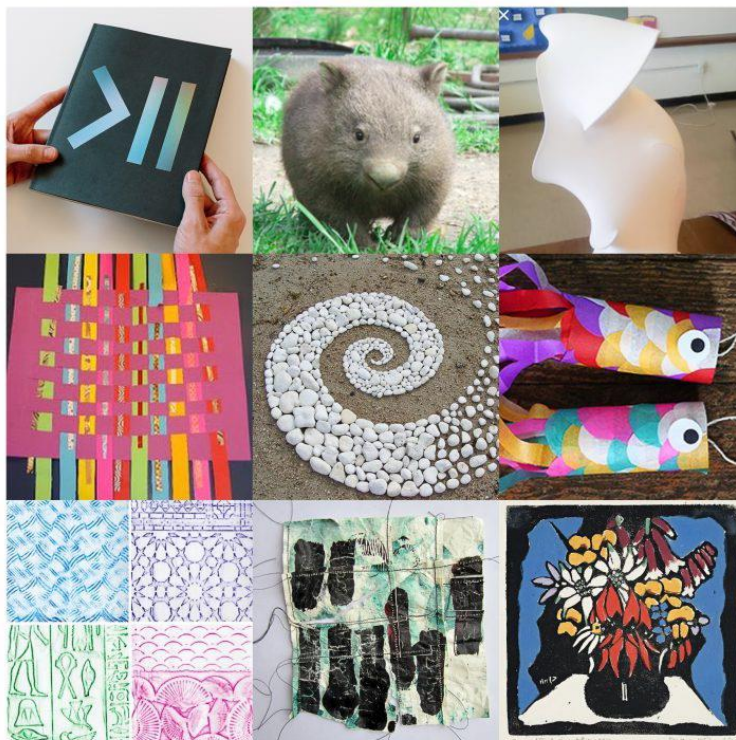


**JANUARY SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROGRAM 2017**
