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At Green Umbrella OSHC we endeavour to extend the children's learning and knowledge by providing opportunities for new experiences within the program. One of the methods for developing this aspect of the program is enabled by incorporating special or themed days in response to local, national or global events and celebrations.

Included in the program and of particular enjoyment (once the hesitation was overcome) was the acknowledgement of Australian Dance Week. To facilitate the children's engagement and their request to be able to utilise technology, the team brought in a Nintendo Wii. A form of technology that requires active participation, as it senses movement. Initially, there were some reservations about dancing in front of one another but with the support and encouragement of their peers and staff, the afternoon of dance was well underway and boy did we use some energy and work up a sweat! Some of the songs that we followed the choreographed moves to were "It's Raining Men", "Hot and Cold", "Womanizer", "Eye of the Tiger", "Who Let the Dogs Out" and the most popular "Cotton Eye Joe"...just to name a few.

This was not only a fun way to acknowledge dance but develop the children's reliance, try something new and promote health and wellbeing.
